


RECAP - Last week we highlighted

GET OUT OF THE CITIES

COUNTRY LIVING, p. 31.4 - *“Out of the cities; out of the cities!”*—this is the message the Lord has been giving me. The earthquakes will come; the floods will come; and we are not to establish ourselves in the wicked cities, where the enemy is served in every way, and where God is so often forgotten.

ADVENTIST HOME p139 - To parents He sends the warning cry: ...*Get out of the large cities as fast as possible.*

COUNTRY LIVING p9 - Again and again the Lord has instructed that our people are to take their families away from the cities...for in the future *the problem of buying and selling will be a very serious one.* We should now begin to heed the instruction given us over and over again: *Get out of the cities into rural districts...*

COUNTRY LIVING p8.2 - There are reasons why we should not build in the cities. On these cities, *God's judgments are soon to fall.*-- Letter 158, 1902.

GOD'S IMPORTANT WORK

EVANGELISM p130 - *In a special sense Seventh-day Adventists have been set in the world as watchmen and lightbearers... They have been given a work of the most solemn import,—the proclamation of the first, second, and third angels' messages. There is no other work of so great importance. They are to allow nothing else to absorb their attention.*

9T290 - *The third angel's message is to be at this time regarded as of the highest importance. It is a life-and-death question.*

6T 60 - *Our message is a life-and-death message, and we must let it appear as it is, the great power of God.*

9MR82 - *The Lord designs that the proclamation of the third angel's message shall be the highest, greatest work carried on in our world at this time*

ONENESS & UNITY

1. **IN ONE LORD** - **John 17:11** Holy Father, keep through Your name those whom You have given Me, that they may be one as We are.
2. **IN ONE FAITH** - **Rev 14:12** Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus.

1a: The Mystery of Godliness

City Exit Plan - Avoid Pestilence & Pandemics

The Watchman, Dec 25, 1906 - John and the other prophets also were witnesses of the terrible scenes that will take place as signs of Christ's coming.

- They saw armies mustering for battle, and men's hearts failing them for fear.
- They saw the earth moved out of its place...
- They saw the vials of God's wrath opened, and *pestilence, famine, and death* come upon the inhabitants of the earth.

The Watchman, Dec 1 1909 - The signs in the sun, moon, and stars have been fulfilled. Since that time earthquakes, tempests, tidal waves, *pestilence, and famines have multiplied.*

1b: The Mystery of Godliness

City Exit Plan - Avoid Pestilence & Pandemics

Last Day Events p95 - Lord calls for His people to locate away from the cities, for in such an hour as ye think not, *fire and brimstone* will rained from heaven upon these cities.

Ministry to the Cities, p114 - Although a few places have been entered, many [city] centers should be established where there would be employed hundreds of workers. In every city there should be a *city mission* that would be a *training school for workers*. Many of our brethren must stand condemned in the sight of God because they have not done the very work that God would have them do.—Letter 56, 1910 (portion in Medical Ministry, 303).

1c: The Mystery of Godliness

City Exit Plan - Avoid Pestilence & Pandemics

Testimonies for the Church, vol. 7, p. 55.2 - Wherever medical missionary work is carried on in our large cities, *cooking schools* should be held; and wherever a strong educational missionary work is in progress, a *hygienic restaurant* of some sort should be established, which shall give a practical illustration of the proper selection and the healthful preparation of foods.

Ministry to the Cities, p122 - I have been given light that in many cities it is advisable for a *restaurant* to be connected with *treatment rooms*. The two can cooperate in upholding right principles. In connection with these it is sometimes advisable to have *rooms that will serve as lodgings for the sick*. These establishments will serve as *feeders to the sanitariums located in the country*.—Testimonies For The Church 7:60. (1902)

2a: The Mystery of Godliness

City Exit Plan - For Country Living

Country Living, p17.1 - He [God] wants them to take their families out of the cities, that they may *better prepare for eternal life.*

Adventist Home, p143 - Those who will take their families into the country ...have a much more favorable opportunity to *gain a fitness for the kingdom of heaven.*

Adventist Home, p142 - ...*an acquaintance with God's useful and beautiful creations* has a refining and ennobling influence upon the mind, referring it to the Maker and Master of all.

Adventist Home, p147 - ...I shall continue to call upon parents to leave the cities and get homes in the country, where they can *cultivate the soil and learn from the book of nature* the lessons of purity and simplicity. The things of nature are *the Lord's silent ministers, given to us to teach us spiritual truths.*

2b: The Mystery of Godliness

City Exit Plan - For Country Living

Adventist Home, p141 - With a Piece of Land and a Comfortable Home —Fathers and mothers who possess a piece of land and a comfortable home are *kings and queens...*

Country Living, p18.4 - ...They could support themselves by raising *fruit and vegetables* and poultry.

Adventist Home, pp137-138 - Let the youth be taught to *labor in tilling the soil*, and let them sleep the sweet sleep of weariness and innocence.

2c: The Mystery of Godliness

Israel Settled in Goshen (Country living)

Gen 47:27 And Israel dwelt in the land of Egypt, in the country of *Goshen*; and they had possessions therein, and grew, and multiplied exceedingly.

Note God's order of communication to prepare Israel for the exodus from Egypt.

- *God desired that Moses* would tell the people they could have faith that God will deliver them out of the hands of a mighty nation like Egypt.
- *Moses* met separately with each group beginning with *Aaron, the Elders, and the people*.
- *Moses told them that God had visited them in response to their prayers for deliverance from idolatry and slavery in Egypt.*
- *Then Moses showed 3 miracles performed by God:*
 - Moses *rod* - turned into a *snake*
 - Moses *hand* - turned *leprous*
 - *Water* turned into *blood*

Exo 4:31 *And the people believed:* and when they heard that the LORD had visited the children of Israel, and that He had looked upon their affliction, then they bowed their heads and worshipped. In practice, the people were fraught with doubt and disobedience.

2d: The Mystery of Godliness

Israel Settled in Goshen (Country living)

Finally, Moses put Pharaoh on notice. Israel will leave Egypt to worship the Creator in the desert wilderness:

Exo 5:3 And they said, The *God of the Hebrews hath met with us: let us go...*

At least 11 times Moses told stubborn and arrogant Pharaoh to let God's people go:

Patriarchs & Prophets p757, EG White Editors - In the command for Israel's release, the Lord said to Pharaoh, "Israel is my son, even my first-born.... Let my son go, that he may serve Me." Exodus 4:22, 23.

The psalmist tells us why God delivered Israel from Egypt: "He brought forth His people with joy, and His chosen with gladness: And gave them the lands of the heathen: And they inherited the labor of the people; that they might observe His statutes, and keep His laws." Psalm 105:43-45. *Here we learn that the Hebrews could not serve God in Egypt.*

2e: The Mystery of Godliness

Israel Settled in Goshen (Country living)

Symbol of the Passover - The people were required to follow the Blueprint closely:

- To obtain freedom they must have faith that God can deliver them
- Every family was to have a pet Lamb
- Blood - was struck on the door posts
- Egypt - Israel must separate from their Egyptian employers and friends. They must secure their families at home
- Goshen - Israel must stay outside of Egypt, else Israel's first born cannot be protected

Abraham - At this time he received the **seal of righteousness** (circumcision). He was told his descendants will be enslaved in Egypt for 430 years.

Gen 15:17 Abraham gave a sacrificial offering and beheld **Christ's Presence** - And it came to pass, that, when the sun went down, and it was dark, behold **a smoking furnace**, and **a burning lamp** that passed between those pieces.

2f: The Mystery of Godliness

Israel Settled in Goshen (Country living)

Moses - Neglected to circumcise (seal of righteousness) his younger son. Hence the Angel stopped Moses from journeying to Egypt. Zipporah circumcised the son lest Moses be slain by the Angel.

Patriarchs & Prophets - In his mission to Pharaoh, Moses was to be placed in a position of great peril; his life could be preserved only through the protection of holy angels. *But while living in neglect of a known duty, he would not be secure; for he could not be shielded by the angels of God.*

In the time of trouble just before the coming of Christ, the righteous will be preserved through the ministrations of heavenly angels; but *there will be no security for the transgressor of God's law.*

Exo 9:10 Moses acknowledge the covenant with Abraham - And they took ashes of *the furnace*, and stood before Pharaoh; and Moses sprinkled it up toward heaven; and it became a boil breaking forth with blains upon man, and upon beast.

2g: The Mystery of Godliness

Israel's Exit Plan - From Egypt

If Moses did not adhere to the Blueprint, then God could not protect Israel from the **7 plagues**

Psalm 91:1-7

Surely He shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler, and from the **noisome pestilence**. He shall cover thee with His feathers, and under His wings shalt thou trust: His truth shall be thy shield and buckler. Thou shalt not be afraid for the terror by night; nor for the arrow that flieth by day; Nor for the pestilence that walketh in darkness; nor for the destruction that wasteth at noonday. A thousand shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand; but ***it shall not come nigh thee.***

Exo 8:22 And I will sever in that day the land of Goshen, in which my people dwell, that **no swarms of flies** shall be there; to the end thou mayest know that I am the LORD in the midst of the earth.

Exo 9:4 And the LORD shall sever between the **cattle** of Israel and the cattle of Egypt: and ***there shall nothing die of all that is the children's of Israel.***

Exo 9:26 ***Only in the land of Goshen***, where the children of Israel were, was there **no hail**.



2h: The Mystery of Godliness

Israel's Exit Plan - From Egypt

Deu 32:10 *God Loves His*

Church - He found him (Israel) in a desert land, and in the waste howling wilderness; He led him about, He instructed him, He kept him as the *apple of His eye*.

Neh 9:19 *Symbol of Christ's*

Presence - Yet thou in Thy manifold mercies forsookest them not in the wilderness: the pillar of the cloud departed not from them by day, to lead them in the way; neither the pillar of fire by night, to shew them light, and the way wherein they should go.

City Exit Plan - Into The Countryside

We too must following the Blueprint on country living

2 Selected Messages, pp.362, 363 - Let everyone take time to consider carefully and not be like a man in the parable who began to build and was not able to finish. Not a move should be made but what movement and all that is portends are ***carefully considered*** – ***everything weighed***... There may be individuals who will make a rush to do something, and entered into some business they know nothing about. .This God does not require ... Let there be nothing done in a disorderly manner, that there should be a great loss or sacrifice made upon property because of ardent, impulsive speeches which stir up an enthusiasm which is not after the order of God, that a victory was essential to be gained, shall, for lack of ***level-headed moderation*** and ***proper contemplation*** and ***sound principles and purposes***, be turned into a defeat.” –

2j: The Mystery of Godliness

City Exit Plan - 4 To Do Lists

1. Location of Property

- a) Are you familiar with the area?
- b) Is it off-grid
- c) Village or town convenience
- d) Check schools or retirement village facility
- e) Check with a real estate agent
- f) Check with someone you know who lives in the area
- g) Check the area prone to fires and/or flooding
- h) Check annual rainfall and other water supply (stream, river, underground spring)
- i) Costs - Electricity, Petrol, natural gas, oil, solar
- j) Costs - Water, Dam water, Bore water
- k) Costs - Council regulations, building consent

2. Long Term Survival -

- a) Simplify, simplify - economize, be prudent and thrifty
- b) Develop country lifeskills - Use of handy tools, gardening, chop firewood
- c) Retrain for new business, trade or jobs
- d) Reduce or remove debt -
 - Rom 13:8 Owe no man any thing
 - Pro 22:7 ...the borrower is servant to the lender

3. Attitude towards Money and Things -

- 1Ti 6:10 For the love of money is the root of all evil
- Mat 6:19 Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth

- 2Pe 3:10 But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up.

- Mat 25:40 And the King shall answer and say unto them, Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done it unto me.

2k: The Mystery of Godliness

Establish A Rural Outpost Centre

Ministry to the Cities, p146, Members Who Congregate Together Called to Wider Service.— Time is fast passing. The day of the Lord's reckoning is approaching. ***Seventh-day Adventists are not to colonize.*** We are to work as Jesus has given us an example... This is the work that will open doors for the truth. ...

Ministry to the Cities, p146, Not to Hide Away in Colonies.— ***This is no time to colonize.*** From city to city the work is to be carried quickly.

Testimonies, Vol. 3, p55.1 - It is ***not the best policy for children*** of one, two, or three families that are connected by marriage, to settle within a few miles of one another. ***The influence is not good on the parties.*** The business of one is the business of all.

Manuscript Release 99, 1908 - If in the providence of God we can ***secure places away from the cities,*** the Lord would have us do this. ***There are troublous times before us.***

3a: The Mystery of Godliness

Establish A Rural Outpost Centre

Publishing Ministry, p114.1 - The Lord designs that through our **publishing houses, our sanitariums, and our schools**, bright beams of light shall shine to the world. Every branch of the work connected with or attached to these instrumentalities should be treated with the highest respect....

Publishing Ministry, p185.1 - God has sent warning after warning that our ***schools and publishing houses and sanitariums*** are to be ***established out of the city...***

Publishing Ministry, p184.3 - It is in harmony with this instruction, that ...the ***publishing houses and the sanitariums*** at these centers have been established away from the congested heart of the cities, as ***outpost centers***.

Ms 196, Apr 29, 1907 - You have said a lot about what might be accomplished by families settling there, about two or three families going into a place where there is no representative of present truth, and starting ***a little center of light***, and having ***a little school***, and ***getting the people together for meetings***, and doing a simple earnest work among them.

3b: The Mystery of Godliness

Establish A Rural Outpost Centre

Country Living, p. 31.3 - We are to be wise as serpents and harmless as doves in our efforts to secure country properties at a low figure, and from these **outpost centers** we are to work the cities.—Special Testimonies, Series B, No. 14, p. 7 (1902).

Country Living, p. 31.1 - **Repeatedly the Lord has instructed us** that we are to **work the cities from outpost centers**. In these cities we are to have houses of worship, as memorials for God; but institutions for the publication of our literature, for the **healing of the sick**, and for the **training of workers** are to be established outside the cities.

Country Living, p30.2 - **The cities are to be worked from outposts. Said the messenger of God, "Shall not the cities be warned? Yes; not by God's people living in them, but by their visiting them, to warn them of what is coming upon the earth."**—Letter 182, 1902.

3c: The Mystery of Godliness

Establish A Rural Outpost Centre

MS 3 Jan 14 1912 - If those who carry the burden of the medical missionary work in... will now study diligently the advantages to be gained by the maintenance of a suitable **outpost center** from which a **strong medical-evangelistic campaign** can be carried forward in...; and if they will plan wisely, and determine to advance in the face of difficulties, light will come in, and courage will take the place of discouragement. As in humility and faith they come to a unity of purpose and plan, God will work for them and with them, and success will attend their efforts.

Ms 107, 1906 (July 25, 1906) - ***Diligent work is now called for. In this crisis, no halfhearted efforts will prove successful in the saving of souls. In all our city work, we are to hunt for souls.*** Wise plans are to be laid, in order that such work may be done to the best possible advantage. More and more, as wickedness increases in the great cities, **we shall have to work these places from outpost centers.** This is the way **Enoch** labored in the days before the flood, when wickedness was rife in every populous community, and when violence was in the land.

3d: The Mystery of Godliness

Establish A Rural Outpost Centre

Evangelism, p77 - We must make wise plans to warn the cities, and at the same time live where we [77] can *shield our children and ourselves* from the contaminating and demoralizing influences so prevalent in these places.—Life Sketches, p. 410. (1915).

Evangelism, p76 —It is God's design that our people should locate outside the cities, and from these outposts warn the cities, and raise in them memorials for God. There must be a force of influence in the cities, that the message of warning shall be heard.—The Review and Herald, April 14, 1903.

3g: The Mystery of Godliness

Do God's Work from a Rural Outpost Centre

God's Amazing Grace, p. 220.3—As Christ was glorified on the day of Pentecost, so will He again be glorified in *the closing work of the gospel*, when He shall prepare a people to stand the final test, in the closing conflict of the great controversy (The Review and Herald, November 29, 1892).

New England Sanitarium, p. 11.3 - *The great crisis is just before us*. Now is the time for us to sound the warning message, by the agencies that God has given us for this purpose. Let us remember that one most important agency is our medical missionary work. Never are we to lose sight of the great object for which our sanitariums are established,—*the advancement of God's closing work in the earth*.

MS 15, 1910 - *A great work is before us—the closing work* of this earth's history.

Solemn indeed is the time in which we are living, and heavy the responsibilities resting upon us as a people. The third angel's message is now to be proclaimed, not only in far-off lands, but in neglected places close by, where multitudes dwell unwarned and unsaved. Our cities everywhere are calling for earnest, wholehearted labor from the servants of God.

3h: The Mystery of Godliness

Do God's Work from a Rural Outpost Centre

Lt 96, 1902 (July 4, 1902) - *We are nearing the close of this earth's history. We have before us a great work—the closing work of giving the last warning message to a sinful world.*

There are men who will be taken from the plough, from the vineyard, from various other branches of work and sent forth by the Lord to give this message to the world.

Ms 118, 1902 (October 6, 1902) - Let us remember that the coming of the Lord is nearer than when we first believed. What a wonderful thought it is that the great controversy is nearing its end. *In the great closing work* we shall meet with perplexities that we know not how to deal with, but let us not forget that the three great powers of heaven are working, that a divine hand is on the wheel, and that God will bring His purposes to pass.

Ms 129, 1905 (December 24, 1905) - *The Lord has declared that the history of the past shall be rehearsed as we enter upon the closing work.* Every truth that He has given for these last days is to be proclaimed to the world. Every pillar that He has established is to be strengthened. We cannot now step off the foundation that God has established. We cannot now enter into any new organization; for this would mean apostasy from the truth.

4a: The Mystery of Godliness

Impossible To Do Unless We Surrender to Christ

Steps to Christ pp47-48 - Many are inquiring, "How am I to make the surrender of myself to God?" You desire to give yourself to Him, but you are weak in moral power, in slavery to doubt, and controlled by the habits of your life of sin. Your promises and resolutions are like ropes of sand. You cannot control your thoughts, your impulses, your affections. The knowledge of your broken promises and forfeited pledges weakens your confidence in your own sincerity, and causes you to feel that God cannot accept you; *but you need not despair.*

Steps to Christ pp47-48 - You cannot change your heart, you cannot of yourself give to God its affections; but you can choose to serve Him. You can give Him your will; He will then work in you to will and to do according to His good pleasure. Thus your whole nature will be brought under the control of the Spirit of Christ; your affections will be centered upon Him, your thoughts will be in harmony with Him.

Steps to Christ pp47-48 - ... Desires for goodness and holiness are right as far as they go; but if you stop here, they will avail nothing. Many will be lost while hoping and desiring to be Christians. They do not come to the point of *yielding the will to God.* They do not now choose to be Christians.

4a: The Mystery of Godliness

Impossible To Do Unless We Yield Our will to Christ?

Steps to Christ pp47-48 - What you need to understand is the true force of the will. This is the governing power in the nature of man, *the power of decision, or of choice*. Everything depends on the right action of the will. *The power of choice* God has given to men; it is theirs to exercise... Through the right exercise of the will, an entire change may be made in your life. *By yielding up your will to Christ*, you ally yourself with the power that is above all principalities and powers. You will have strength from above to hold you steadfast, and thus through constant surrender to God you will be enabled to live the new life, even the life of faith.
